EcoNile Activities Summary

We aim to provide youth with environmental knowledge, attitudes, and solutions, with a focus on climate change, and to bridge the gap between academia and society by allowing local communities and students across Sudan to benefit from learning about the various aspects of Climate Change and Environmental Sustainability, as well as possible career opportunities in the field and how their field of expertise could be used in the most effective way to contribute to environmental sustainability and combat climate change.

Online Events

The aforementioned Econile facilitated a series of interactive lectures on many topics of climate change, including the following:

> The Current Challenges and the Future Sustainability Opportunities



Dean of the Engineering Faculty at Gaza University, detailed the staggering challenges preventing our future's sustainability, including everything from emissions to biodiversity, as well as opportunities to fix or assist in meeting and facing those challenges.



ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT

Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA): Presented by: Dr. Osman Mirghani.

EIA was discussed in detail, as well as the importance of clear legislations in this area backed by strong institutions that are guided and directed by qualified human resources, the importance of activating effective follow-up procedures and research and development for further innovation.



CLIMATE CHANGE ON SUDAN

Climate change impacts in Sudan: Presented by: Dr. Somia Zakieldeen.

The session tackles climate change impacts on Sudan, vulnerability and adaptation, IPCC data projections about climate change, biodiversity, temperature objectives, GHG gas sources. The UNFCCC's role in promoting global solutions to climate change was also discussed, as well as the implementation of international measures such as the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement - all of this with relation to both national and international situations.

COMMITMENT OF SUDAN TOWARDS CLIMATE CHANGE CONVENTION

Sudan's Commitments toward the Climate Change Convention: Presented by: Rehab Ahmed Hassan.

The session discussed the causes of climate change and its potential consequences, the UNFCCC's duties in greater depth, and Sudan's commitment to various agreements and sectors covered in the SDG framework, followed by the challenges encountered in implementing those protocols. Moreover, the lecturer discussed the role of the Higher Council for Environment and Natural Resources (HCENR), climate change institutions, what has been accomplished thus far, and recommendations related with lessons learned, as well as gaps and challenges facing UNFCCC's implementation in Sudan.

WATER IN UNESCO & SUDAN OPPORTUNITIES

Water in UNESCO and Sudan Opportunities: Presented by: Prof. Abdin Muhammad Ali.

The session delves into the history of water in the UNESCO as well as the international hydrological program. The session also touched on Sudan and IHP, as well as the UNESCO broad water family. Furthermore, it discussed the future of the UNESCO in Sudan and how Sudan can benefit from the UNESCO's opportunities. Numerous questions at the end of the session covered a wide range of water-related topics.





Climate Change Causes, impacts, and Sudan experiences

Climate Change Causes, Impacts, and Sudan Experiences: Presented by: Dr. Ismail Elgizouli.

The session carefully explained the science of climate change, the environment nternational efforts to face this phenomenon through adaptation and mitigation, as well as the impacts of it on Sudan (sectors and ecological systems affected). It also tackled Sudan's commitments toward climate change agreements and the methods to benefit from them. Our guest concluded the session by answering questions from the audience.
